

1. Q: What inspired you to write Winnie Goes to School?

A: I wrote the story during my family's first year living in Arizona, and I had no idea the desert bloomed in spring! My inspiration was the beauty of the Sonoran Desert and a funny story my youngest daughter told me. I was busy learning all I could about the unique plants and animals of our new home when my daughter told me the comical tale of a bird who flew into her first-grade classroom— not once, but twice! The children thought it was hilarious! I knew for my story, the bird would be a Cactus Wren. These birds are known for their curiosity and mischievous escapades! Winnie the Cactus Wren was born!

2. Q: How does being a pediatrician and mother affect how you write?

A: As a pediatrician, I have always been passionate about the health and well-being of children. I believe that reading is an essential part of a child's development and that books can be a powerful tool for teaching children about the world around them. As a mother, I understand the importance of finding books that are both fun and educational for children. Because I found learning about the Sonoran Desert so intriguing, I wanted to share that with my young readers. There is a "Fun Facts About the Sonoran Desert" spread at the end of the book that is meant to share extra facts for older children and inspire further reading. My goal is to write positive, engaging stories that encourage children to be curious, kind, and life-long learners.

3. Q: What are deeper themes adults will notice as they read the story?
